1	Diana Gifford-Tuggle	Shasta County does not provide a return envelope nor postage.
2	Amy MacDonald	Tulare County does provide a return envelope (no postage).
3	Edwina Harper	Yolo County is the same as Tulare County
4	Therese Phelps	Plumas is the same as Fresno. The questionnaire folds back together with the address on the outside. The juror has to put their own postage on it.
5	Sherry Spears	Fresno says NO, that was one of the reasons we didn't go with the model summons, it would have required an envelope. Our summons is a self-mailer, jurors can complete the one side and fold and the address is on the other side.
6	Gail Schults	Inyo - We don't due to expense
7	Alison Blackwell	San Diego does include a return envelope; not postage paid. I suspect if we didn't include an envelope we would get significantly fewer back resulting in increased FTAs.
8	Robyn Hauck	Yuba County is a two-step county. We send an initial questionnaire – one page folded, we use tabs to close it. The potential juror completes the questionnaire, re-folds it and tosses it in the mail. So we pay for return postage of the questionnaire, no envelopes provided. Our summonses do not provide anything for return.
9	Cathi Scamara	San Luis Obispo does include an envelope (no postage)
10	Shana Simpson	Sacramento is the same as San Luis Obispo
11	Melannie Looper	Same for Placer
12	Diane Collins	Mendocino County does provide the return envelope, postage not included. Cost vs no return of excused/postponed jury service is deemed worth the cost.
13	Richard Goldner	Ventura is as Mendocino County. Including a correctly addressed small envelope without postage is cheaper than the alternative scenario mix.
14	Kathleen Shambaugh	Contra Costa is the same as Mendocino / Ventura.
15	Arlene Cervantes	In Riverside we provide a return envelope without postage, with the jury summons
16	Debbie Jurevich	San Benito used to have an envelope without postage included. We have recently changed vendors and we no longer provide the envelope. Things appear to be working out just fine.
