Do any of you email jurors that are in process of a situation like this? If so, how do you collect their email addresses? What is your process to send the emails?

1	Debbie Cravea	In Napa, we do not have a policy in place for emailing the jurors...although we would be interested to hear if other courts do....
2	Diane Collins	Mendocino County does not e-mail jurors with the information, but I do put it on the web site so they can check it for themselves.
3	Amy McDonald	Tulare County is the same as Mendocino. Jurors are placed on call and instructed to check back at 11:45 to possibly report at 1:00 pm. This information is listed on our phone recording and web site.
4	Lupe Castaneda	Santa Clara County does not email jurors
5	Margaret Smith	Tuolumne County is the same as Tulare and Mendocino
6	Carol Sharek	Tehama County is the same as Tulare.
7	Diana Gifford-Tuggle	We do not email jurors. If they are released for lunch they are ordered back to the assembly room at a specific time. There are times when a panel of jurors will be instructed that jury staff will call them individually with further instructions. We also have the further reporting instructions on our web site and reporting IVR line.
8	Sherry Spears	Not in Fresno, we either have the juror check back with us or we call them. With large groups we have them check via the automated system. E-mailing is a good idea, would love to work it into our IVR/IWR system for jurors to input their own e-mail, would be a lot of work otherwise
9	Rose Hamblin	Kings County doesn't email.
10	Lynda Pierini	Madera We do have email access for jurors to request a postponement, but not for reporting instructions. That would be way too much work to email all jurors expected to report back in the PM. I agree with Sherry/Fresno, it would be nice to incorporate the email with the IVR/IWR. We do on our jury questionnaire have a place the juror can enter their email address and is then incorporated into JSI.
