3	Patty Baker	We have a bar code scanner that checks jurors in. They do not self scan. We have a scan gun that we run across their bar code. We have a front counter they stop at and we scan the bar code at the top of their jury summons. Every morning the jurors report. Service is usually for one week (M-F) I give them a full orientation once all jurors have arrived and are seated N/A We either excuse or defer—we make a notation in our system.
