4	Cathi Scamara	San Luis Obispo - We do send a postcard with each postponement and the statement which is on the postcard is listed below: Your request to reschedule your jury service is granted. Your new date for service is noted above. You will receive another summons with updated service information about 3 weeks prior to your new service date.
