1	Diane Collins	If a report of potential jurors for the week is given to an attorney it has their name only. I get it out of JSI reports and cut off all bar codes, group numbers and ID numbers.
2	Sherry Spears	Fresno doesn't and the only way we would is after a CCP 237 hearing where the court grants the release of juror information
3	Joe Yniquez	Stanislaus doesn't. Also, can't release any info provided by DMV pursuant to CCP 197(c).
4	Edwina Harper	In Yolo County we do the same as Fresno and Stanislaus County
5	Lynda Pierini	Madera - The only way I would supply personal information on a juror is by court order and jurors have been notified that it will be released. We do not collect Social Security #'s
6	Shana Simpson	Sacramento has the same business practice as Fresno.
7	Debbie Jurevich	San Benito County follows the same procedure as Madera Superior Court
8	Arlene Cervantes	Fresno's process is the same for Riverside
