

REGISTRAR OF VOTERS – LIST OF US NON CITIZENS or NON COUNTY RESIDENTS

I've been asked for information regarding the court providing a list of jurors to the Registrar of Voters indicating all those who have submitted affidavits stating they are not U.S. citizens and/or not county resident.

Do any of you provide this to your Registrar?

Is there any code section requirements?

1	Fresno	When a juror claims the non-citizen disqualification and we notice that the source was from Voter Reg., we'll initially deny the request for additional information. If the juror confirms that they are not a U.S. citizen we'll provide the information to Voter Reg. There is not code section that I'm aware of that requires.
2	Mendocino	Does provide a copy of the summons stating they are non-citizens to the ROV office. I do not do that for non-residents.
3	Los Angeles	We have done this in the past when requested by the Registrar of Voters. I don't think they have asked for a couple of years, now
4	Kern	We do provide a report to the ROV (generated from JSI Next Gen) on a semi-regular basis which shows any summonsed juror who is disqualified on their jury Questionnaire Form or other juror-related document as a non-citizen and where the source of the name and address is the Registrar of Voters. The report prints the juror's name, address and date of birth. Along with the report we provide a copy of the juror's signed questionnaire form, FTA card or other juror-related document and the ROV file number shown on their detailed juror information.
