

SWORN/ALTERNATE JURORS

In your county, do you give jurors who serve on a trial (sworn and alternate jurors) a longer exemption from being placed back into the jury pool (beyond the 12 months)? If so, how long are they exempt?

1	Lupe Castaneda	Santa Clara County all jurors receive an 18 month exemption
2	Bea Gin	San Joaquin County, jurors who report and are given attendance by the staff in the Jury Assembly Room (potential, sworn, alternate, etc.) are exempt from further summoning for the remainder of that year plus the following year. A juror cancelled by phone or website is eligible to be summoned the following year.
3	Joe Yniquez	Stanislaus is 18 months.
4	Debbie Cravea	Napa, Sworn and Alternate are give 2 years before they are eligible again.
5	Diane Collins	Mendocino is the same as San Joaquin
6	Diana Gifford-Tuggle	Shasta County sets these jurors out approximately two years.
7	Sherry Spears	In Fresno County we only exempt for the 12 month period
8	Carol Sharek	Tehama is the same as Shasta County – two years.
9	Edwina Harper	Yolo County, sworn and alternate jurors are excused for 12 months.
10	Dolores Curiel	Merced County is the same as Fresno, 12 months
11	Shana Simpson	Sacramento is the same as Santa Clara.
